The Conference Advisor:

- Supports a single or multiple technology focus and makes recommendations for content and or helps recruit presenters to submit abstracts
- Are expected to meet 3-5 times / sessions throughout the year with the event development team
- Will have access to review the submissions in their track, following the close of the official call for speakers; including the details of the authors and make recommendations
- May consult with other subject matter experts as needed to fulfill expectations
- May assist with session leaders, and or act as session leader
- Will review all final selected speakers/content in the technology track assigned
- Help promote the FABTECH Conference Program
- Conference Management retains final discretion on abstract acceptance and scheduling speaker submissions
