



According to data from the National Chamber of the Iron and Steel Industry (Canacero) Mexico is the **15th largest steel producer in the world,** employs more than 700,000 people directly and indirectly, and in 2019 alone production was 18.4 million tons of liquid steel.

The manufacturing sector represents 17.3% of GDP in Mexico. (2019) INEGI

Mexico is the seventh largest importer of machine tools in the world, importing almost one billion US dollars.

MONTERREY

Monterrey is known as the Industrial Capital of Mexico. It is one of the main business centers of the country and is the industrial and economic epicenter of northern Mexico.

It is the cradle of large national and international companies, recognized for its consistent industrial development, education, strategic location for foreign trade, quality of life and ease of doing business.

Nuevo Leon is positioned as the state with the highest foreign direct investment (FDI) accounting for 2,805.2 million dollars, representing 8.7% of the national total.
